Song “Speak, O Lord”

The 10 Commandments

Leader: I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. You shall have no other gods before me.

People: We will serve the God of our salvation as the one and only true God.

Leader: You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. For the Lord your God is a jealous God, punishing the children for the sins of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

People: Nothing will come between us and our love for God.

Leader: You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

People: We will not use God's name as a mere exclamation or expression. We will speak of him only with deep respect and love.

Leader: Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work. But the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God—on it you shall not work, neither you nor your son or daughter, your man servant or maid servant, nor the aliens within your gates. For in six days the Lord created the heavens and the earth, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore, the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

People: We will find our true spiritual and physical rest in God alone through Jesus Christ.

Leader: Honor your father and your mother so that you will live long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.

People: We will live gratefully in the salvation that God has provided, honoring all God-given authority.

Leader: You shall not murder.

People: We will nurture human life as God's precious gift.

Leader: You shall not commit adultery.

People: We will live purely and joyfully with the gift of sex.

Leader: You shall not steal.

People: We will work diligently and share our possessions with others.

Leader: You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

People: We will build our neighbors up speaking only the truth about them and to them. We will love them even as we love ourselves.

Leader: You shall not covet you neighbor's house. You shall not covet you neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maid servant, his ox or donkey, or anything else that belongs to your neighbor.

People: We will be grateful and satisfied with the good things that God provides us through Jesus Christ.
